Dear Chairwoman Brown Dutrieuille,

I write to request a review of the recently enacted rate increase by Aqua Pennsylvania, Inc (Aqua) for water and wastewater services in Chester County. I have heard from numerous constituents concerned that the rates now in place are not within the limits approved by the Public Utility Commission (PUC).

Despite overwhelming opposition from ratepayers, and myself, in May of 2022, PUC Commissioners voted to approve a rate increase for water and wastewater services provided by Aqua. While residents anticipated an increase, many have been surprised and frustrated to receive bills that have exceeded estimates previously provided by Aqua. Multiple constituents, including seniors on fixed incomes, have shared their bills have doubled, a cost burden that may require them to relocate.

According to the attached Commission Final Allowance, the PUC approved an overall rate increase of 54% for wastewater services in New Garden Township, Chester County. According to Keep Water Affordable, a local consumer advocate group, residential usage accounts for 82% of the wastewater revenue in the township. Only one of the 23 attached residential rate brackets submitted by Aqua received less than a 54% increase. The vast majority of rates have an increase of over 80%. While these figures do not consider commercial revenue, I believe it would be prudent to review the implemented amounts. Please advise what steps ratepayers can take to ensure their bill is true to their usage and the approved rates.

It is important to me that the PUC review this matter and recognize the immense difficulties this rate increase has caused for residents of the Commonwealth.
